

Capacity and Program Limitations

Due to the hands-on nature of the workshop incursion program, there is a strict maximum number of students that we can accommodate per session. Our team is able to present for a maximum of 2 hours and can visit 2 classes during this time (1 hour max. per class). We will prepare consumables and equipment for a maximum number of 32 students per class.

Working with Children Check

All Telethon Kids research and staff members visiting your group have a current 'Working with Children' check and a Police Clearance as a condition of employment. Telethon Kids staff are able to present their 'Working with Children' checks at your request.

Duty of Care

While the Telethon Kids research and staff members will be responsible for running the session with the students, duty of care remains the responsibility of Group Supervisors. Group Supervisors must be present at all times during

Special Needs and Allergies

It is the responsibility of the Group Supervisors to advise Telethon Kids if any students have any special needs or allergies.

Set-up and Pack-down

Telethon Kids will provide at least two presenters to run the incursion. Unless stated otherwise in your Incursion Booking Confirmation Form, they will arrive approximately 30 minutes before the program is due to begin with all the required equipment. Please arrange for someone to meet them and show them to the session area(s). Due to the hands-on nature of our workshops, we will need access to the space 30 minutes before and after the sessions to setup and pack down. A minimum time of 30 minutes is needed between the two sessions to reset the workshop.

Please note that our workshop sessions require a projector, interactive whiteboard, screen or similar, with audio, to enable our team to present. The hands-on activity our team will conduct with your students during the session will be confirmed with you through email at time of booking. Please inform us of the type of presenting space(s) we will have access to during the session so that we can plan suitable activities for the space.

Parental Consent

Telethon Kids takes no responsibility for any parental consent required for children to take part in the incursion session. The group coordinator takes responsibility for ensuring appropriate consent is sought prior to the incursion taking place.

Cancellation Policy

Unless there are exceptional circumstances, if you do not provide the required notice the group will be charged a \$50 cancellation fee. Groups that do not provide any notice of cancellation and fail to attend on the day will be charged the full flat rate of \$125 + GST.
